All competitors must have their AIRC membership card with them at all times and present it when asked by any official.

Competitors attending the AIRC National Eventing Championships should note the following information:

Show Office

The Show Office will be open from 08:00 until 18:00. We would ask you to only call to the office in person if necessary.

Entries & Withdrawals

Please email any withdrawals to <u>info@airc.ie</u> and include your competitor number, name, club, horses name and the class you are withdrawing from.

Any change of horse must be notified to the show office and any changes must be registered in advance of competing. Failure to do so is in breach of AIRC rules and will result in disqualification.

Changes to teams are only permitted up to 8:30am on Sunday morning and must be notified via email to info@airc.ie.

Competitor Times

Dressage

All competitors have been issued with a time and must compete at that time. If you do not turn up at your designated time, we will not be able to accommodate you later so please turn up on time!

All times are approximate for your class and you must keep an eye on your designated arena to ensure you turn up on time.

You do not need to check in on the day of the event. Please proceed straight to your arena. The pocket steward will have your details.

All competitors must co-operate fully with the stewards with regard to presenting themselves in time for their respective competitions.

Show Jumping

A whiteboard system will be in operation for the show jumping phase where competitors have not been issued with an actual time. Competitors must register with the steward at the show jumping arena no later than 15 mins after the last dressage test in the competition. If you do not turn up on time, you will not be permitted to continue.

Cross-Country

Competitors will jump in strict numerical order for cross-country. If you miss your spot, you may be allowed to go out at the end of the class, only if time permits.

Competitor Number

Competitors must print their own number for their Number Bib, using the template provided. Please remember that you must print two copies of your number, one for the front and one for the back of your number bib.

Equine Passports

All horses must be accompanied by an Equine Passport. Spot checks will be carried out and those found without an equine passport will be liable to a fine up to a maximum of €1,000 and / or disqualification from the competitions entered.

Equine Influenza

All horses must be vaccinated against equine influenza, and must have an up-to-date certificate of vaccination as per rule 21. Vaccination certificates must accompany all horses.

Results & Updates

Results will be available on https://airc.ie/airc-national-eventing-championships-2025/during this event so you can check your progress throughout the competition.

It must be noted the that online scoring is provisional and is provided for information purposes. Any queries that you may have, **must be submitted to the show office** on the day of the competition.

No queries or objections will be entertained after 30 minutes of the result being declared for the competition as per rule 19.

Prizegivings

Presentations will take place during the day and will be announced over the PA on the day. Individual and team winners are asked to attend in riding attire for a presentation photograph. Any uncollected prizes can be collected from the Show Office thereafter.

Please ensure to collect your prize or rosette(s) before going home, along with your test sheets!

Other Information

- Hat tagging will be available on-site, please contact the number above upon arrival or drop into the Show Office.
- There will be no farrier service available at this event.
- Onsite catering will be available.
